- A bigger question changes what we see, who belongs, and what becomes possible.

 01 PURPOSE expands the question.	FOR OUR COMMUNITY What larger future are we trying to build that no organization can create alone?	FOR ME What am I willing to serve that is larger than my role, title, or organization?
 02 STORY expands what we can see.	FOR OUR COMMUNITY Whose experience could change how we understand this issue?	FOR ME What might I not be seeing because of the experiences and assumptions I bring?
 03 VOICE expands who has authority.	FOR OUR COMMUNITY Who needs to be present early enough to shape the question?	FOR ME Where should I use my voice - and where should I use my influence to make room for someone else's?

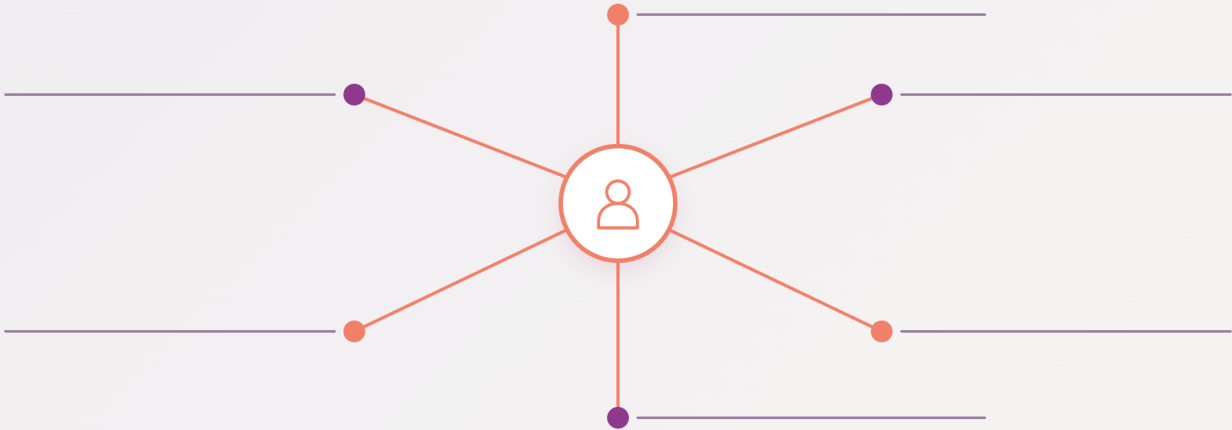
